Hope House School is a registered centre for ASDAN (Award Scheme Development and Accreditation Network) through which pupils have access to a wide range of subject courses, both practical and academic.

ASDAN brings together subject areas including PSHE, Citizenship, Careers and many more, incorporating them into individual courses that provide pupils with the skills, core knowledge and understanding to enable them to realise their potential, making them ready to participate in the wider world.

Towards Independence courses offer practical life skills and experiences while New Horizons and Key Steps combine practical life skills with PSHE, Citizenship and Careers. Short Courses and the Bronze, Silver and Gold awards are stand alone courses but can also be counted towards AoPE and CoPE. Courses are also awarded UCAS points with CoPE level three being equivalent to AS level B grade.
